Today's update will be relatively short and sharp, as we wait to see what the Government announces tomorrow afternoon. I've heard a few of us are starting to get cabin fever and are chomping at the bit to get back to work. I can definitely sympathise and appreciate the enthusiasm, but at this stage we'll continue to follow the guidance in the expectation the restrictions will be lifted soon.

Our wider team continue to have conversations with our customers in anticipation of an alert level shift. If this is the case tomorrow, an appropriate work pack will be released later in the afternoon, detailing Delta's requirements under the new alert level status. However, if we do remain in Alert Level 4, it will be because the Government deems the risk of shifting us too high, and is looking out for our best interests. Keep calm, stay patient.

I know that the shift in our day-to-day routine, new work environment and the uncertainty of the virus, can create additional strain and stresses on some of us. Please make sure you use the support mechanisms in place, such as EAP services, to help you or your family at this time. Also ensure that you stay connected with your work teams and keep checking in to make sure everyone is coping okay.
