



## **COVID-19 RESPONSE PLAN: UPDATE 26**

26 May 2020

The Prime Minister has announced that from midday Friday 29 May, New Zealand will increase its gathering size to a maximum of 100 people. We will be staying in Level 2 for now, but the Government will be checking-in on 8 June, and a decision regarding Level 1 will be made no later than 22 June (exactly 4 weeks from yesterday's announcement).

What this means for Delta is, we will continue to work to the guidance outlined in our Level 2 safe working protocol pack released on 12 May. The only amendment to this pack is that there is no longer a requirement for meal breaks in our lunchrooms to be staggered. Physical distancing rules (1-metre) still apply, as do the rest of the rules outlined in version 2 of our Operational Recovery Plan, under Level 2 (attached to this email for your reference).

As more aspects of our everyday lives begin to feel more normal, we must continue to be mindful that we keep the same level of vigilance. Personal hygiene, contact tracing, and staying home if you are unwell, are still key during this time. As mentioned in our Level 2 pack – alternative work arrangements are still available and encouraged. Please ensure that conversations between managers and employees are happening, and the best work approach is achieved.

Please continue to stay safe and be kind. As always, regular updates will be communicated as more information becomes available.
