



COVID-19 RESPONSE PLAN: UPDATE 21

8 May 2020

Yesterday's Government announcement gave us better clarity of what Level 2 looks like, once it's safe to move there. The operational work pack that was distributed when we moved to Level 3, is now being reviewed and amended where necessary.

The key points that stood out for me yesterday, were:

- Level 2 can only be successful if we 'Play it Safe' - we do not want a second wave.
- Bubbles are no longer required - however space, hygiene and contact tracing is still essential.
- Indoor & outdoor gatherings are limited to 100 people or less.
- Workplaces should consider whether people can continue to work from home.
- Education facilities will open under Level 2, but will also continue online.
- Domestic travel will be opened, however we must be extremely vigilant if travelling.
- If you are sick (even slightly), please stay home.
- Level 2 may need to be a phased approach.

More detail on whether we will move to Level 2, will be released by the Government on Monday at 4:00pm. We will release communications on Delta's next steps on Tuesday.
