As we begin to settle into Alert Level 1, I wanted to thank everyone for their hard work and dedication during this time. We experienced a significant amount of change, and each time we adapted well to our new environment. In saying this, the announcement of 2 new cases, is a timely reminder that our hard work doesn't stop here. We must remain vigilant and keep following the requirements, to help keep the virus at bay.

1. If you are sick, stay home
2. If you have cold or flu-like symptoms get tested
3. Wash your hands, Wash your hands, Wash your hands
4. Sneeze and cough into your elbow and regularly disinfect shared surfaces
5. If you are told by health authorities to self-isolate you must do so immediately
6. If concerned about your wellbeing or you have underlying health conditions, consult with your GP
7. Keep track of where you've been and who you've seen so we can use that for contact tracing if needed
8. Businesses should help with rule seven by displaying a QR code
9. Stay vigilant

All Delta depots are now displaying their unique QR code at main entry points, for staff and visitors to use - helping you keep track of your movements. All you need to do is download the NZ COVID Tracker app from the App Store or Google Play Store and scan the code upon entry. For those who are not in the office, you can continue to use the Contact Tracing Form on the ResponseAbility app, or keep your own diary.

As mentioned in the previous update, we are collecting the improvements we received off the back of our COVID-19 experience so far, and are working on an approach to fold this into the way we do things. More information will be released on this in the coming week.
